The RIC is an innovative financial tool managed by Piemonte Agency, aimed to encourage the arrival and development in Piemonte of investments in industry, services and research from abroad.

Beneficiaries: small, medium and large companies wishing to locate an operating unit in Piemonte

Sectors: production of innovative goods and services, renewable energy

Initiatives: creation of new production or service facilities and headquarters, restructuring or conversion of an existing production plant or re-activation of inactive plants or facilities, creation of R&D centres, competency and design centres, laboratories; development of research projects

Guarantees: rapidity and certainty of timing for administrative procedures, investment support with grants or soft loans, commitment of the local authorities, universities and research bodies involved, the creation of infrastructures, the running of research activities in cooperation with the company, assistance in all stages of the project
