It presents a web platform to monitor agri-food chains: management of weather forecasts, tracking of crop treatments, operations performed, promotion of end products.

2. CSP – Innovation in ICT – innovation and research sector - www.csp.it

Research Centre that develops applied research activities, agreements and cooperation projects at a local, national and international level, with public agencies, local authorities and large private enterprises. At CeBIT it presents innovative technologies, including an interactive multitouch screen.

Second time at CeBIT. – The Isaac Team is a group of student from Polytechnics University of Torino, fascinated by robotics, who are presenting Isaac Robot I2 at CeBIT, a third generation humanoid robot that competes in international championships and events.
